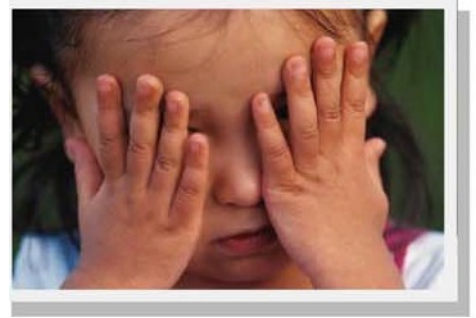


Disaster Backpacks

\$10 Donation + shipping: buys 1 UNFILLED child's backpack, shipped to a club at a business address (no P. O. Box).

\$20 Donation + \$1.50 per backpack for transport fees to disaster location: buys 1 FILLED child's backpack, kept at the district store for when disaster occurs.

\$30 Donation + \$1.75 per backpack for transport fees to disaster location: buys 1 FILLED adult backpack, kept at the district store for when disaster occurs.
